## HOT DRINKS

### English Breakfast (black tea)

A hearty, bright and lively blend made from Assam Tea

### Birds of Paradise (green & white tea)

A fruity and lively combination of white and green tea blended with marigold petals, safflowers, apple and peach

### Earl Grey (black tea)

A traditional black tea flavoured with oil of bergamot and blended with cornflowers. This light tea has a delicate citrus aroma and a strong, fragrant taste

### Peppermint (herbal infusion)

Light and fresh this herbal tea will leave you feeling restored

### Camomile Flowers (herbal infusion)

Camomile tea is a light, fresh and floral aromatic tea with hints of apple-like flavour renowned for its soothing capabilities

### Assam (black tea)

A full-bodied, rich and malty large leaf black tea

### Smugglers Gold (black tea)

Blended using the very best of Assam, Kenyan and Ceylon tea leaves resulting in an aromatic, full flavour

### Berry Berry (fruit infusion)

This tea has a strong flavour of juicy berries. It is the perfect balance of sharp fruits and sweet berries

### Chai (black tea)

An exotic, spicy and warming black tea blended with cardamom, ginger and cinnamon

### Darjeeling (black tea)

Often described as the 'Champagne of teas', Darjeeling is lighter than most black teas, with a distinctive fruity, muscatel character

### Pinhead Gunpowder (green tea)

A tightly rolled green Chinese tea, which is bold in taste and smooth in texture. The leaves are rolled into pellets giving it a gunpowder like appearance

### Jasmine (green tea)

Fresh and light with a slightly floral taste and sweet aroma from the aromatic jasmine flowers

### Lapsang Souchong (black tea)

A distinctive, golden tea smoked with pinewood reminiscent of campfires and its travelling origins

### Lemon & Mango (fruit infusion)

An infusion of dried lemons and mangos, this fruit tea is both refreshing and invigorating

### Superior Black (black tea)

Assam, Kenya, Ceylon and Darjeeling teas are blended together to result in something 'Superior'. This tea has a malty taste with a slight floral aroma

### Ceylon Pekoe (black tea)

Considered one of the best tasting teas, Ceylon has a distinct flavour, aroma and strength full of character with a rich fragrance

### Rooibos Red Bush (red tea)

A rich, earthy and almost nutty flavour caffeine free tea originating from South Africa

### Cloud Catcher (fruit infusion)

A blend of fruit including kiwi, sour cherry, coconut flakes and cranberry. Providing distinct, fruity and tart notes with refreshingly sweet undertones

### Peach Sencha (green tea)

A refreshing and sweet blend of Japanese Green Sencha tea fragranced with essential peach oils

### Spring Garden (green tea)

A blend of Japanese Green Sencha with strawberry and rose. Ideal when the sun is making an appearance in the sky.

### Chocolate & Coconut (black tea)

A blended Ceylon black tea including real coconut pieces giving this tea an element of nuttiness, whilst rich oils are released from real chocolate pieces to give this drink a luxurious mouthfeel

### Crème Caramel (red tea)

A naturally caffeine free red tea renowned for its caramel undertones, enhanced by real caramel pieces.

A refreshing and sweet blend of Japanese Green Sencha tea fragranced with essential cherry oils
